## RELIGIOUS + CULTURAL

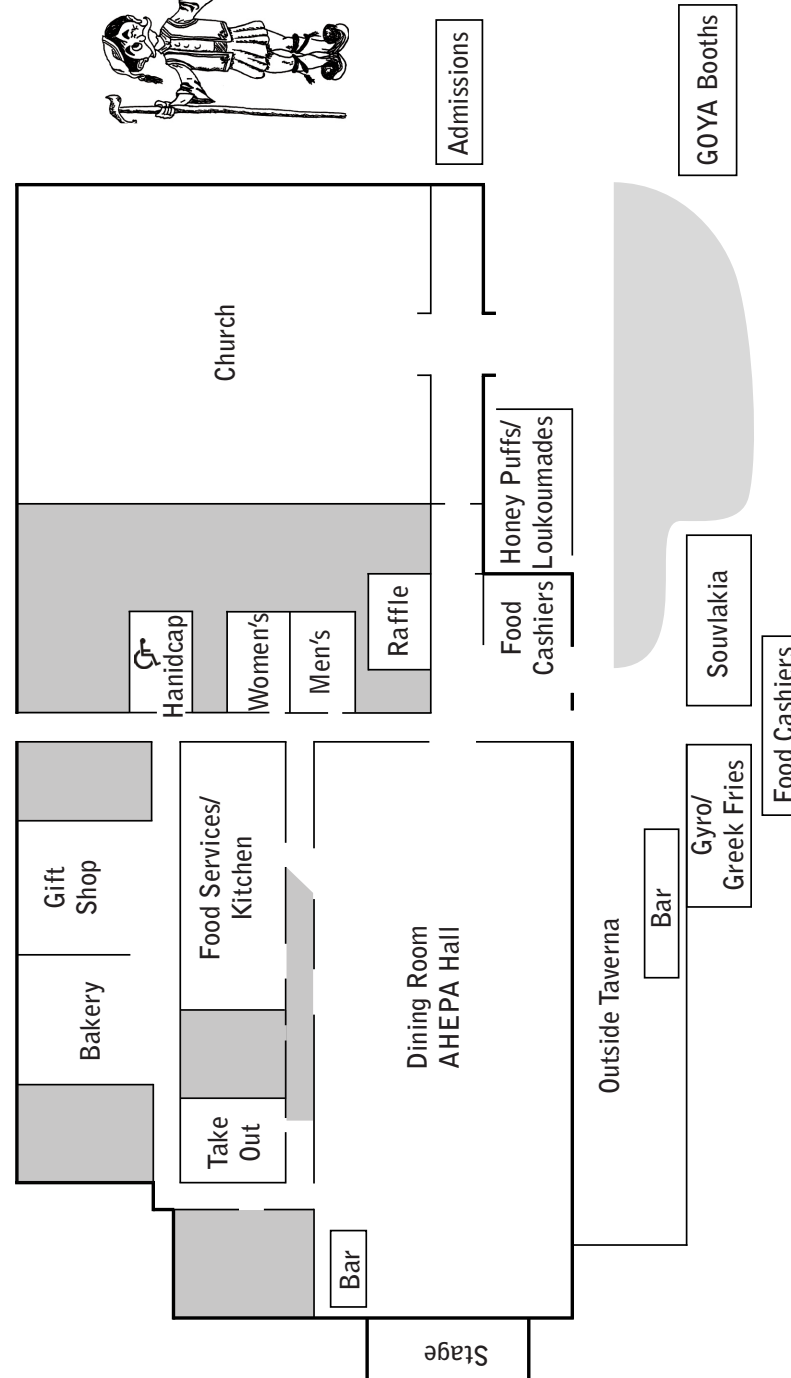
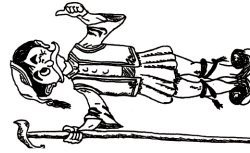
Guided church tours will be available throughout the weekend. Tours will last for 30 minutes and provide visitors a religious education of the Greek Orthodox Church.
